

Blues for ladies

WOMEN'S FOOTBALL: After being pipped to the Cheshire and Manchester League title by Fletcher Moss, Winsford ladies were beaten in the League Cup final 3 – 2 on Sunday by the same opposition.

But, in front of a crowd of nearly 200 Winsford were the better side overall.

A 40-yard screamer by Danielle Lydiate gave Winsford the edge at half-time. But Fletcher Moss levelled shortly after the restart and then missed a penalty.

On 71 minutes Kylie Kettle found substitute Laura Renshaw in space and she gave Winsford the lead.

Five minutes later Presland was sent off for a foul outside the box and Fletcher Moss levelled from the free kick.

Even with 10 players Winsford looked the better side, but the deciding goal came in the second period of extra time.

Winsford need a point against Bury on Sunday to win promotion to the North West Counties League.
