



Ladies Corsa cup upset

WINSFORD Ladies continued their excellent start to the season by cruising into the quarter finals of the Challenge Cup.

And to make the feat all the more impressive they did so at the expense of the unbeaten Division One leaders Vauxhall Ladies.

Winsford started the brighter of the two teams and created two good chances in the first 10 minutes, but it took a brilliant individual goal from top scorer Sarah Lee on 14 minutes to give them a well-deserved lead.

Vauxhall rarely threatened against the best defence in the Cheshire and Manchester Ladies League and Winsford wasted several more good opportunities to extend their lead.

Vauxhall started the second half with good possession and created two good opportunities, a well-worked move saw them equalise on the hour.

Winsford responded brilliantly to this by dominating the rest of the match.

On 66 minutes Danielle Lydiate hit a shot from 40-yards which flew into the net to give Winsford the advantage again.

And they extended the lead to 3 – 1 on 80 minutes when a superb pass from Sharon Tidd, found Lee and she buried the ball in the bottom left corner.

Lee completed her hat trick five minutes from time when she scored from close range following a corner to make it 4 – 1.
