

Ladies' seven deadly goals

WINSFORD ladies notched up their sixth consecutive win on a cold afternoon at Vauxhall Ladies to stay top of the Cheshire and Manchester Women's League Division 1.

Winsford started brightly and were a goal up after only 3 minutes when the home team failed to clear a corner and a low drive from the edge of the box from Sharon Tidd gave Winsford the advantage.

It was 0 – 2 five minutes later thanks to top scorer Sarah Lee who finished off an excellent passing move by finding the corner of the net.

Vauxhall could not cope with the pace of the Winsford wingers Becky Hilditch and Michaela Thompson and it was from such a move the Kylie Kettle collected the ball and drilled a shot beyond the keeper into the corner of the net.

On 17 minutes another wonderful flowing move from Winsford found Thompson in space on the left wing and her low cross into the box was superbly finished by Sarah Lee.

Vauxhall finally got the ball out of their own half and had the cheek to score, which provoked an immediate response from Winsford.

On 38 minutes a well delivered cross from Becky Hilditch was finished off in style by Sharon Tidd and, just before the break, Kylie Kettle completed the half-time rout.

The second half was a non-event with Winsford guilty of wasting chances in front of goal.

Vauxhall notched a late consolation goal to give the score line more respectability, but it was Winsford who took all the credit with a 6 – 2 victory.
