Lee hat-trick leaves Winsford ending season on high

WINSFORD Ladies signed off their debut season in the North West Women's League in style on Sunday.

They thumped Macclesfield Town 4 – 2 to score a seventh success in 11 matches, a run that earned them fifth place in the final standings.

“We can be proud,” said manager Tony Lee.

“After winning promotion last year we have moved up another level and showed we can compete – now we can't wait for next season already.”

His team had seen shots hit the woodwork three times at the weekend before they broke through at the start of the second half when Sarah Lee applied the finishing touch to Kylie Kettle's assist.

Macc bounced back to lead 2 – 1 only for Lee to level.

She then completed her hat-trick with a wonder strike from distance to edge the visitors ahead before Vicky Jones sealed the points by adding a fourth.

Winsford started 2009 penultimate bottom in Division One South after winning only one of their opening 11 matches, also lost 3 – 0 at Buxton in midweek.
